WEC Programmes

London Heathrow

(approx. 2 hrs 45 minutes from Weymouth)

Arrival: arrive at Heathrow between 09.00 and 17.00 – our travel leaders will meet you and take you to Weymouth on one of our transfer coaches. Our coaches depart from Heathrow at 13.00 and 18.00.

Return: book a flight that departs from Heathrow any time after 14.00 – our travel leaders will take you to Heathrow.

Other airports/times

We will arrange for a taxi to meet you at the airport and take you directly to your host family. On the return journey the driver will help you check in if you are under 16. Please see price list for details.



Travelling with parents

Your parents can take you directly to / collect you from your host family. You should arrive between 16:00 and 21:00 on the Sunday and depart by 10:00 on the Saturday.

Any students not choosing one of the above three options must be accompanied to and from Weymouth by an adult.

VISA INFORMATION

If you are the citizen of an EU country or Switzerland, Iceland, Liechtenstein or Norway, you should not need a visa but from 1 October 2021 you need a valid passport to travel to the United Kingdom as other ID is not accepted. Otherwise, for visa requirements, you should check with your nearest British Embassy or Consulate or look at the Foreign and Commonwealth Office website at http://www.ukba.homeoffice.gov.uk/.

HEALTH INSURANCE

You must arrange or already have medical insurance before the start of the course and you must bring the insurance certificate with you. Alternatively, we also

CHILD SAFETY

The safety of our students is very important to us. Weymouth and Portland has proved to be a safe area for our courses. We will send you full information about your stay in England before you come to Weymouth including information about staying safe. We will also go through these points with you on your first day at school and answer any questions you might have.

Starting Dates:

In 2025, courses are held between 30th June and 8th August with the arrival on Sunday and departure on Saturday. The minimum stay is 2 weeks. Please note that four-week stays are only available for students aged 16 and 17.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Weymouth English Centre transfer coach/minibus - available for flights arriving at Heathrow on Sundays between 09:00 and 17:00 and departing from Heathrow on Saturdays after 14:00.

Check-in/Unaccompanied Minor Service - £50

On departure, students under 16 will be assisted with check-in and accompanied to security. When Unaccompanied Minor service has been arranged with the airline, a member of our team will hand the student over to the airline representative. Unless we are otherwise notified, this service will automatically be supplied and invoiced.

Terms and conditions

1. Enrolment

To book a course please fill out the booking form or use the online form on our website. We will then reserve a place and send you details of how to pay the deposit of £150. You should pay the deposit within seven days in order to secure your place. The rest of the course fees should be paid three weeks before your course starts

2. Cancellation by the student

You have a legal right under the Consumer Contract (Information, Cancellation and Additional Charges) Regulations 2013 to cancel the contract within 14 days ("Cancellation Period") without giving any reason. The Cancellation Period will expire 14 days from the date of our booking confirmation. To cancel you must inform us by a clear statement. You may use the cancellation form at

http://www.weymouthenglishcentre.com/cancellation or send it by email or post. The cancellation is only valid when it has been acknowledged by the School.

We will not start providing services to you during the Cancellation Period unless you expressly request us to do so.

If you cancel within 14 days, we will refund the fees you have paid within 14

days after we receive your cancellation. However, if you have expressly requested that we start providing services within the Cancellation Period then we will be entitled to charge you a reasonable sum for those services and we will deduct this sum from any refund payable to you.

If you cancel after the Cancellation Period, the School is entitled to compensation for the work already done and expenses incurred. In calculating such compensation, expenses and work saved is taken into account.

Cancellation fees are as follows:

- more than 30 days before your course is due to start: £75
- between 30 and 15 days before your course is due to start: 30% of the total fees
- between 14 and 7 days before your course is due to start: 45% of the total fees
- less than 7 days before your course is due to start: 75% of the total fees

If your visa is refused, we will refund the money you have paid us minus an administrative fee of £60 provided we receive the original letter of refusal from the British Embassy at least one week before your course is due to start.

3. Medical information

Any medical, physical or mental conditions which might affect the stu-dent's stay in Weymouth must be disclosed in full at the time of booking. If any relevant information is not fully disclosed, the School has the right to send the student home at the student's expense.

4. Replacement person

Up to the date of the start of the course the student may find a replacement student to take over his or her rights and responsibilities. The School has the right to reject such a replacement person if he or she does not comply with the requirements of the course or his or her partic-ipation would be in contravention of any appropriate laws or regulations.

If a replacement student takes the place of the original student, both the replacement student and the original student are jointly responsible for ensuring that the course fees are paid together with any additional costs incurred through the replacement of the original student.

5. The course offer

The course is provided according to the description contained in the brochure for the relevant course town and course type. Any lessons or activities which are included in the package but not used by the student cannot be refunded unless the School incurs lower costs as a result of the non-participation of the student.

6. Notification of claims

If any part of the course is not provided as described in the brochure, the student should notify a course leader or our office in order that the matter can be rectified immediately. If the student fails to notify the school of any such complaint, he or she is not entitled to any subsequent compensation.

7. Responsibility of the student

The School has rules which are designed to ensure the safety of the students at all times. The student must follow the rules of the School. If he/ she fails to do so a warning will be given. If the student continues to fail to obey the rules of the School, then the School has the right to send the student home at the student's expense. In this case the School will make reasonable efforts to contact the student's parents or legal guardians to inform them accordingly. It is the responsibility of the student's parents to supply full contact details in advance of the course.

Student Behaviour:

If a student behaves in a disruptive manner, the School reserves the right to send the student home by air at the student's or the parents' expense. If a student engages in any criminal activity, he/she will immediately be sent home by air at the student's or the parents' expense, even if criminal proceedings have not been instigated by the police. All students are expected to abide by the rules laid down by the School and by the families. All students should be home by 22:00.

Alcohol:

There are specific laws relating to drinking alcohol and visiting pubs in Britain. No-one under 18 years may buy or consume alcoholic drinks. Young people aged 15-17 can only go into pubs if accompanied by a responsible adult. The School rules regarding pubs reflect these legal requirements.

Drugs and Illegal Substances:

Any student found in possession of drugs or any illegal substances will be sent home by air immediately at the expense of the parents or the student.

8. Liability of the school

Weymouth English Centre, its staff, representatives and host families will not be liable for any loss, damage, illness or injury to persons or property, however caused, except where such liability is imposed under UK law. It is the student's responsibility to take out insurance to cover all such risks. We also advise students to take out insurance to cover any costs of cancellation or curtailment of the course. Weymouth English Centre will not be held liable in any way if any service contracted to be supplied by them becomes impossible to supply as a result of any industrial or other dispute which is outside the School's control.

9. Insurance

Students must arrange or already have medical insurance before the start of the course and must bring the insurance certificate with them. The School also offers comprehensive student insurance.
